


Fig.1 Fig.2 Fig.3 Fig.4 Fig.5

NO.1 OneSmart - Registration / Login Sign up for a OneSmart account

If you don't have an account, please register or register with SMS verification code. This page describes the registration process.

- Touch to enter the registration page (Fig.1) and accept the "information for the privacy".
- The system automatically recognizes your country / area. You can also select your prefix. Enter your phone number or Email and tap "Get Verification Code" as indicated on page 7 (see Fig. 6 and Fig. 7).
- If you entered the phone number or Email, enter the verification code as indicated in Fig.4, then enter the password and tap "Confirm" to complete the registration.
- If you have registered the E-mail, enter the password and tap "Confirm" to complete the registration as shown in Fig. 5.




Fig.3 Fig.4 Fig.5 Fig.6



NO.1 OneSmart - Registration / Login Login with OneSmart username and password

- The system automatically recognizes your country / area. You can also select your prefix. Enter your phone number or e-mail and tap "Next".
- Enter your registered phone number or E-mail and password to login.



NO.2 OneSmart - Add device manually ("Add manually")

- Press "M" at the top right of the page to enter the network connection page Wi-Fi as shown in the figure. There are two types of network connection: manual (manually add) and discovery automatic.
- The user can press in the upper right corner to change the connection method from manual mode to automatic mode.
- In manual mode check that the light on the device to be connected is flashing quickly (2 flashes per second), press and go to the next step.
- If the indicator is not flashing quickly, press "change mode pairing" to see the instructions to follow.

NO.2 OneSmart - Add device manually ("Add manually")

Note: how to set the "fast" flashing light on the indicator

- Step 1**
Turn on the device
Turn off the device after 10 seconds and then turn it back on
- Step 2**
Press the reset button for 5 seconds
- Step 3**
Check that the indicator light is now flashing quickly



NO.2 OneSmart - Add device automatically ("Automatic detection")

- For this mode check that the indicator lamp is flashing slowly (once every 3 seconds), press and go to the next step.
- If the indicator is not flashing slowly, press "change mode pairing" to see the instructions to follow.



NO.2 OneSmart - Add device automatically ("Automatic detection")

Note: how to set the "slow" flashing light on the indicator

- Step 1**
Turn on the device
Turn off the device after 10 seconds and then turn it back on
- Step 2**
Press the reset button for 5 seconds
- Step 3**
Check that the indicator light is now flashing quickly
- Step 4**
Press the reset button for 5 seconds until the indicator flashes slowly

NO.2 OneSmart - Add device - Enter Wi-Fi password
Enter Wi-Fi password

Select the Wi-Fi under which device is working, enter password and confirm to enter network connection process.

NO.3 OneSmart - Device Control
Device configuration

After you have successfully configured the device, it will appear on the home page. Select the device to control it.

Note:
1. When the device is "online", the control screens are available.
2. When the device is "offline", it cannot be controlled.

NO.3 OneSmart - OneSmart - Scenarios

On the "Profile" page, users can manage the following main information:

- Device Sharing: View information about shared devices
- Message center
- FAQ and feedback
- Configure

NO.4 OneSmart - Profile
OneSmart profile ("Profile")

The "profile" page contains all the personal information of the account. You will be able to change the login password, add the phone number and set the unlock pattern for the page.

NO.4 OneSmart - Account and security
Profile - Unlock pattern

Select "Gesture password" to set your unlock pattern which you will then need to set to use the application.

NO.4 OneSmart - Shares
Profile - Shares

Send share
The list shows all members who have been added from your account. You can delete a member and delete the share by swiping left.

Shares received
The list shows all the devices that have been shared with you. You can delete the share by swiping left.

NO.4 OneSmart - Profile
Profile - Account and security

Add share ("Link Telephone Number")

As shown in the figure, the user can enter the phone number of a new member and share the device with him. The new member will be able to control the shared device.

Includes notifications of new devices and shares.

Where users can post their feedback and shares.
